PRAYING PSALM 110

"The Lord said to my Lord, 'Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool (Psalm 110:1).

This one of the most quoted psalms in the New Testament. Jesus is presented as the Messiah. 1. MESSIAH AS KING (1-3). I will make Your enemies Your footstool. The Lord shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of your enemies. 2. MESSIAH AS PRIEST (4). You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek. 3. MESSIAH AS VICTORIOUS WARRIOR (5-7). During the millennium Messiah will rule earth from Zion on the throne of David. Christ combines the offices of priest and king, like Melchizedek.

Ultimate judgment on God's enemies will not come in our lifetime. Injustice will prevail until Jesus returns as the Righteous Judge. For now, you must commit your enemies to Christ and trust in the grace of your High Priest. Don't ruminate on injustices and unjust people. They may be a problem, but they are not your problem to solve. Once you have committed them to God you are free to go about your life knowing the Judge of all the earth will do right.
