

PRAYING PSALM 126

“The Lord has done great things for us, and we are glad” (Psalm 126:3).

This psalm is about the restoration of Jerusalem after the Babylonian captivity. 1. REJOICE IN THE LORD'S DELIVERANCE (1-3). The great deliverance for us is our salvation. 2. PRAY FOR THE DELIVERANCE OF OTHERS (4). We should pray for the Lord to save others. 3. TAKE CONFIDENCE YOUR PRAYERS WILL BE ANSWERED (5-6). The reward of intercession is based on the law of sowing and reaping. Sowing in prayer can be tearful, but reaping brings joy.

Intercession is your most difficult task as a Christian. It requires a lot of sowing. It is arduous. It is slow. It requires patience. It is sure, however, there will be a harvest. Be constantly praying for the salvation of others. Pray for the restoration of those you know who are in captivity to the enemy. “Let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart” (Galatians 6:9). Pray in confidence that God will hear you. The joy will be worth the weeping.
