

PRAYING PSALM 135

“Praise the Lord” (Psalm 135:1)!

The theme of this psalm is praising the Lord. 1. A CALL TO PRAISE THE LORD (1-4). Who is called to praise the Lord? Those who serve. Those who lead. Why? Because the Lord is good. Because it is pleasant to praise the Lord. Because we are His treasure. 2. THE LORD WE ARE CALLED TO PRAISE (5-18). He is the Lord of creation. He is above all gods. He is sovereign; He does whatever He pleases – In Heaven; In earth; In the waters. He is the Lord of Victory – In Egypt; In the wilderness; In History (13-14). He is the God of the gods (15-18). He is the Lord of His people (19-21).

You are called to praise the Lord. Praise Him because He is LORD. He is your Creator. He can do whatever He pleases, and it pleases Him to love you. He gives you victory over your enemies. He is the only God. He ordained your history. He is your Savior. He is sovereign. If you can't think of any other reason, praise Him because He is.
