

## PRAYING PSALM 26

“I have walked in my integrity... I will walk in my integrity...” (Psalm 26:1, 11).

David prayed about his integrity. 1. I HAVE WALKED IN MY INTEGRITY (1-10). (David listed qualities that were demonstrated in his personal walk). I have trusted the Lord without wavering. I have walked in your truth. I have not sat with idolatrous mortals or hypocrites. I have hated the wicked. I will wash my hands in innocence. I have loved your house. David asked the Lord to examine him. 2. I WILL WALK IN MY INTEGRITY (11-12). David committed to do what is right. He took a stand.

Integrity is the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles. Integrity comes from integral, and has to do with being whole and undivided. A person with integrity is the same on the inside as the outside. The Hebrew word means complete. That is a worthy goal. Are you willing to pray about this? To be complete is to walk in integrity. Ask God to reveal inconsistencies in your walk, then ask Him to strengthen your walk. Stand on what you know to be right.
