

PRAYING PSALM 65

“Praise is awaiting You, O God, in Zion...” (Psalm 65:1).

This song is pure praise. David ascribed praise that will one day flow from Jerusalem during Christ’s Kingdom. But, you don’t have to wait to praise God 1. PRAISE FOR SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS (1-5). He provided atonement. He chose us for Himself. He answers us when we pray. 2. PRAISE FOR NATURAL BLESSINGS (6-13). These include the mountains, the seas, the rivers, the rain, the pastures with their flocks, and the valleys.

“Praise God from whom all blessings flow.” Praise God for the natural as well as the spiritual. Earth is natural. It is the habitat for humanity. When you thank God for the natural, you honor Him as the God of the earth. Join the psalmist, and praise God for the cross which made the way for Him to choose you for Himself. When you have done that, praise God for what you see and hear around you. Never cease to be amazed at what God has done in and through nature. Jesus is the Lord of heaven and earth.
