

PRAYING PSALM 75

“When I choose the proper time, I will judge rightly” (Psalm 75:2).

This psalm teaches that God is sovereign in His own world, demonstrated by the fact He delivers the righteous and punishes the wicked. God’s sovereignty is evidenced by: 1. THE DIVINE STABILITY OF THE UNIVERSE (1-3). God’s judgment is certain. It will come at the proper time (2). God’s judgment is righteous (2). The earth and all its inhabitants will be dissolved (3). (See II Peter 3:7-13). The pillars are firm, and the foundations of the earth are established, assuring nothing can happen to it until God is ready to create a new earth (Hebrews 12:25-28). 2. THE DIVINE JUSTICE OVER THE WORLD (4-10). God rebukes the wicked for their boasting, pride, and stubbornness (4-5). God gives reasons for His justice (6-10). He is the Judge: God puts down one and exalts another. Judgment belongs to Him alone. Judgment will be poured out when He is ready.

The more you study the psalms, the more you realize that justice will not come until Christ comes. The only answer to injustice is ultimate the judgment Jesus will bring. Judgment will not come until there is a falling away from faith and Antichrist is revealed. God’s Christ will return and consume the wicked with the breath of His mouth and the brightness of His coming (II Thessalonians 2:8). The stability of the universe will sustain this planet until Christ returns for the purpose of judging the unjust and rewarding the just.
