

PRAY PSALM 8

The theme of this psalm is Divine revelation. There are two kinds of revelation. The WORD is SPECIAL revelation. CREATION is NATURAL revelation. This psalm has to do with the natural revelation of the heavens and man.

The glory of God is revealed in creation, and we ought to praise Him for it. God's glory is greater than the heavens. The heavens reveal His glory (1). God revealed Himself in His children to tell of His strength, silencing God's enemies (2). The Heavens are the works of His fingers (3). Man (Adam) was small compared to the heavenly galaxies, and so are we, but God, is mindful of us even in our fallen condition. He honored us (4-5) by allowing us to reign over His creation (6-8). His purpose for us is that we should exalt His name.

Thank the Lord for revealing Himself in creation. Thank Him for His excellent name and His glory. Thank for revealing Himself in the heart of every newborn child. Thank Him for taking notice of you, as insignificant as you are compared to His glory. Thank Him for seeking you in your fallenness so you could respond to His grace by receiving Jesus as our Savior and Lord. Thank Him for allowing you to have dominion over His creation. Exalt the Lord, because of who He is, what has done, and what He is doing.
