

PRAYING PSALM 94

“How long will the wicked triumph” (Psalm 94:3).

This psalm is a prayer about the wicked. 1. CONCERN OVER THE WICKED (1-11). It is useless to worry about the wicked. They speak insolent things. They boast in themselves. They break God’s people. They slay the widow and the stranger. And they say that the Lord does not see. God hears. He sees. He corrects. He knows the thoughts of man are futile. 2. CONFIDENCE IN THE RIGHTEOUS ONE (12-23). Take confidence in His Word. Take confidence in His promises. Stand up for God against the evildoers. Trust in God’s mercy to hold you up. Have no part in laws which derive evil. Trust in God as your defense. Trust God to cut off the wicked when He is ready.

You should intuitively be concerned about the presence of evil in this world. To be concerned is not the same as to worry. To be concerned is to stand against this present evil world. Don’t ignore it. To do that is to do what God is not willing to do. God hears and sees evil. He knows the hearts of men. Don’t hide from the evil you see. Expose it. Stand for right. Be concerned, but don’t worry. Place your confidence in Christ the Righteous One. God will stand with you. When the world runs its course, God will destroy all evil. You will be delivered from this present evil age (Galatians 1:4), and you will inherit an eternal age of righteousness.
