

PRAYING PSALM 95

“Let us sing to the Lord! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation” (Psalm 95:1).

There are two calls in this psalm: 1. CALL TO WORSHIP (1-7a). Come is an invitation. We are invited to come before His presence. We are to shout joyfully before Him. We are to worship the Lord, the great King above all gods. We are to worship the God of the earth, of nature, of the sea. We are to worship God as Maker. As the people of His pasture we are to worship our Shepherd. 2. CALL TO REPENT (7B-11). Today. When you hear His voice don't harden your hearts. Don't continue to go astray. Seek His ways.

It is uncommon to receive an invitation from a sovereign to enter his throne room. The Lord, the Maker of the Universe invites you into His presence. You are summonsed to worship the Creator of Heaven and earth. You are called to appear before God without reservation to worship Him and thank Him for being your Shepherd. As sheep of His pasture you can be led into the still waters of His presence. Will you accept Jesus' invitation? Will you enter in? If you are not accustomed to being in the presence of Jesus, repent and appear before Him today. Don't allow yourself to continue to stray. Seek Him in the quiet place of prayer. Enjoy the rest of submission to His will.
