Prophecy devo #9: the Gentiles

Prophecies regarding the Gentiles began with Noah. After the world-wide flood, humanity came to be divided into three groups. A licentious bent showed up in Noah's son Canaan's undefined act of immorality. Canaan was cursed to servitude.
