Proverbs 1:4. "To know wisdom...understanding...knowledge." (read vs. 2-4)

Wisdom is a gift from God (Prov. 2:6). It comes with understanding and knowledge, forming three moral attributes of the Spirit within those who believe. The world is head over heels on information; the Lord is concerned with truth. Information (providing it is correct) isn't truth but evidence for or against any given proposition. Wisdom, understanding, and knowledge are avenues of truth, and attributes of the Holy Spirit. The Bible is the revelation of truth by the Holy Spirit. When we are born again we receive the Spirit, and receive the abiding of eternal Truth within us. The Holy Spirit is an inner template that matches the external Word of Truth. *You have an anointing from the Holy One, and you know all things* (I Jn. 2:20). The *Anointing* abides in believers and teaches us (I Jn. 2:17). The Book of Proverbs majors on the nature of truth. It is an OT primer on wisdom and its attributes. "Christ...became for us wisdom from God" (I Cor. 1:30). To know wisdom is to know Christ. Study the depths of Christ by reading Proverbs through each month. Wisdom is waiting for you.
