EVIDENCE FOR HUMAN ORIGIN

"And God made the beast of the earth according to his kind... Then God said, Let us create man in Our image, according to our likeness; let them have dominion...over all the earth... So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them" (Genesis 1:25-27).

A primary law of thought is that an effect cannot be greater than its cause. In other words, water does not rise any higher than its source. Therefore, the effect cannot have any more than what was placed in it by the cause. According to natural selection, not only did nothing produce something, but the nonliving produced the living, and the nonrational produced the rational. Human language is a human distinctive that demands a Creator. Language is unique. Apes, for instance can't speak, neither can they learn to speak. Geisler records the experiences of scientists who unsuccessfully attempted to teach a chimpanzee how to speak a human language. One of them commented: "Chimps do not have any significant degree of human language and when, in two to five years, this fact becomes properly disseminated, it will be of interest to ask, 'Why were we so easily duped by the claim that they do?'" Language is one of the primary features of being human. It is one of the gaps between the primates and man that cannot be bridged.
