Revelation 1:10 – "I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day."

LISTENING TO THE SPIRIT

Humanly speaking, if John were not in the Spirit, the Book of Revelation would have never been written. John does not describe this as an exciting experience but as a direction by God to write. The Vision of Revelation is not what is important to us here, but the fact that it is possible to be in spiritual state where God reveals His will to you in a way you know it is from Him. The Book of Revelation came from listening to the Spirit. I understand that the Spirit does not give new revelations today, but I am not afraid to say He can give you new directions. He also wants to teach you by giving you fresh insights into the Word. The Spirit also wants to reveal new insights about yourself. Those insights come more easily when we are in the Spirit.
