Revelation 14

VISIONS & VOICES FROM HEAVEN

- Rev. 14 consists of a series of forecasts and visions assuring believers that Christ will ultimately triumph and judge the wicked
- Rev. 14 emphasizes 2 truths:
 - The 144,000 will be preserved through the Tribulation
 - Pronouncements of divine judgment upon the wicked
- Though the saints may suffer, and even be martyred, God's ultimate justice will triumph. The Wicked will be judged & the saints will be rewarded
- The visions in Rev. 14 summarize events that will be described in detail later

1. VISION OF THE 144,000 (read 1-5)

- a. Singing about redemption
- b. Unmarried & pure
- c. Loyal to the Lamb
- d. Firstfruits to God & the Lamb 1st of many saved during the Tribulation
- e. Speak God's truth without compromise

A DESCRIPTION OF WHAT IT MEANS TO BE FAITHFUL TO JESUS:

- a. Testimony of redemption
- b. Morally pure
- c. Follow Christ
- d. Faithful to the Word
- e. Practice what they preach

2. VISION OF ANGEL #1 (read 6-7)

- a. Preaching the Gospel to everyone who has not heard
- b. What he preaches: Fear God & worship Him. Judgment has come

This Gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness to all nations; and then shall the end come (Matthew 24:14).

3. VISION OF ANGEL #2 (read 8)

- a. Announcing the fall of Babylon
 - Babylon is the source of Antichrist's religious & political ideas (Nimrod)
 - Religious Babylon will be destroyed in Rev. 17
 - Political Babylon will be destroyed in Rev. 18

Babylon...shall be as when God overthrew Sodom & Gomorrah. It shall never be inhabited, neither shall it be from generation to generation: neither shall the Arabian pitch his tent there; neither shall shepherds make their fold there (Isa. 13:19-20).

b. Antichrist's religious, political, economic system will be destroyed

4. VISION OF ANGEL #3 (read 9-13)

- a. All who worship the beast will experience the wrath of God (9-10)
- b. The beast will be eternally punished in the Lake of Fire (Rev. 20:1-15)
- c. This judgment is a reward for those who kept (and keep) the Faith
- d. Believers who die from now on will not miss the blessings of the kingdom

5. VISION OF THE SEPARATION OF THE TARES FROM THE WHEAT (read 14-16)

- a. A description of Matthew 13:36-43, 49-50
- b. Good seed separated from bad seed. Tares burned. Wheat saved

6. VISION OF THE DESTRUCTION OF ARMAGEDDON (17-20)

I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples no one was with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger, and trampled them in My fury; Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have stained all My robes. For the day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come (Isaiah 63:3)
