THE LAST PRAYER

This is the last prayer in the Bible. Last words are usually significant. What is the significance of this prayer? II Peter 3:11-18 says we should be holy in conduct and godliness. We should wait for and earnestly desire His coming. We should look for new heavens and a new earth. We should look forward to those things. We should be diligent to be in peace, without spot or blemish. We should understand that the Lord is waiting to allow more time for people to be saved. We should watch out and not be carried away by the errors of wicked people. We should grow in grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We should give Him the glory now and forever. Can you say, “Even so come Lord Jesus?” Start from the beginning with the prayer of the disciples, “Lord, teach us to pray.” Find your secret place, and shut the door. Go before Him in silence. Meditate on the Word, and wait on Him. Stay in fellowship through prayer. Keep praying. Don’t give up. Give thanks in all things. If your prayers aren’t being answered, change the way you pray. Expect Jesus to return at any time. Finally, pray this prayer often: “Even so, come Lord Jesus.”
