

CREATION VS. EVOLUTION: THE FINGERS OF GOD

Psalm 8:3-4 – “When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained, What is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit Him?”

The Barred Spiral Galaxy is 69 million light-years away in the constellation Eridanus. Francis Chan comments: “Why would God create more than 350,000,000,000 galaxies (and this is a conservative estimate) that generations of people never saw or even knew? Do you think maybe it was to make us say, ‘Wow, God is unfathomably big?’ Or perhaps God wanted us to see these pictures so that our response would be, ‘Who do I think I am?’ I think the answer is both. When I consider the heavens were made by the fingers of God I feel infinitesimally small. Yet, with dexterity and imagination God made me. I was formed in a womb and was fearfully and wonderfully made. I can’t comprehend why God made me for Himself. The galaxies are no more miraculous than a man or a woman. We are all miracles of creation. Science says we came from one woman named Eve, but not the Eve of the Bible. Eve means life-giver. Now isn’t that amazing? How close can we get to God and not recognize He is the “Big Bang” that spoke everything into existence? Eve was created to bear children in the likeness of the One who created her. The womb of a mother is the way God continues His creation process through procreation. Every newborn child is a fresh visit from God to remind us of Who He Is. God used His fingers to create the universe. He uses a womb to populate a planet He uniquely created for man.
