PURPOSE

Beta Pictoris is located 63 light-years away in the southern constellation Pictor. Although the star is much younger than the sun, it is twice as massive and nine times more luminous.

John MacArthur said, "Believing in a supernatural, creative God who made everything is the only possible rational explanation for the universe and for life itself. It is also the only basis for believing we have any purpose or destiny. By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the thing which are seen were not mad of things which are visible (Hebrews 11:3).

The ultimate concern is God or nothing. To believe in nothing is to deny "He has placed eternity in their hearts" (Ecclesiastes 3:11). That is the effect of evolution. It attempts to remove the innate knowledge of a Creator, which all societies have ever acknowledged, and replace it with a hope of nothing, except what is in this present life. That is the faith of the evolutionist.
