WHAT IS MAN (PART III)

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth... Then God said, Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness... So God created man in His own image...male and female He created them" (Genesis 1:1, 26-27).

The person who can't believe Genesis 1:1 is the person who doesn't want to. Anyone who will not believe Genesis 1:1 needs not bother reading the remaining 31,101 verses in the Bible. If on the other hand bodies have energy where did they get it? If minds have intelligence where did they get it? If a watch doesn't have a watch-maker where did it come from. Reasoning from effect to cause demands not only a starting point but a powerful intelligent Designer who is before all things and who is responsible for all things. Like I said, it is a matter of faith. I don't have enough faith to be an evolutionist.
